**Day 2: Purpose:** Ask God to give new vision and bring clarity to OUR purpose as a Church. Jeremiah 29:11 - Ephesians 2:10 - Romans 8:28

**Day 3: Spiritual Growth:** Ask for God to move in the life of our Church during this time of prayer and fasting, Pray for spiritual Maturity in our body. Colossians 1:9-10 - Ephesians 4:14 - 1 Corinthians 13:11

**Day 4: Relationships:** Pray for God to bring the right people into life and strengthen the right relationships in your life. - Psalms 128: 3 - Ecclesiastes 4:12 - Ecclesiastes 4:10

**Day 5- Perspective:** Pray for God to give us kingdom perspective as we fast rationalism so we can live a life understanding that is not possible to prove with the mind what is born of the spirit. "Our lack of understanding cannot sabotage the power of the purpose of His voice". Proverbs 3:5-6.

**Day 8- Habits and Goals:** Ask for God to help you sustain good habits in your life and accomplish your goals. Proverbs 16:3 - Proverbs 29:18 - 1 Timothy 4:8

**Day 9- Healing:** Pray for those physical and spiritual areas of your life that need healing and remember we serve a God who heals even on Sabbath (John 5:1-18), a God who has no limits and is always working all things for your good. He does not hide, He heals!

**Day 10: Heart:** Ask God to give you a heart like his!

**Day 11: Eyes:** As God to give you eyes like his!

**Day 12: Our body:** The temple of the Holy Spirit, the place where He dwells. **Pray for wisdom and courage** to take care of our bodies as the place where He lives and be encouraged to live a life daily realizing that our bodies are actual parts of the Body of Christ. 1 Corinthians 6:19.

**Day 13: Families:** Pray for Jesus to impact people's homes and families, Psalms 127 3-5-

## **Week #3: SOUL**

**(Why Everything that Matters Starts Inside of You) Book Resources: How's Your Soul: Judah Smith**

**Day 15: Spend time in prayer truly answering the question "How's Your Soul?"** Being healthy begins on the inside. 3 John 2 -Psalms 103:1

**Day 16: Revelation:** Be attentive today to God's conviction regarding any way in which you are willfully deceiving others or yourself. If He shows you an area to attend to, be encouraged: God does not reveal sin or weakness to mock us. God reveals to heal. Psalm 139: 23-24. James 5:15. Psalm 103:3.

**Day 17: Pray for the Souls of those who are lost:** Pray that they are reminded that He who created them is waiting for them with arms wide open to meet them wherever they are at.

**Day 18: Empathy:** Ask God to awaken us from our numb slumber and reveal to us His where, when and how of any tables that need to be overthrown in our generation. Philippians 4:2-5.

**Day 19: Rest:** Matthew 11:28-29. Rest is not the absence of problems or projects. Rest is the presence of Jesus! He is our only source of true rest. **Pray today about finding time every day to go to rest** believing every single time you will be restored, refueled and revived physically, spiritually and mentally.

**Day 20: God's will:** Remember a time in which your emotions and God's will were not in perfect sync, were you fear what the future would hold, a moment you had to be obedient to God's voice and disregard your desires. Remember what Jesus did before going to the cross and be encouraged to stay obedient acknowledging that obedience is not a moment but a process connected by countless moments and fast premature resolution (John 12:27-28), be friend undone, name the problem and talk to your father God about it.
